<p>Action Plan (close the loop): The practicum checklist scores indicate that CNM CYFD students in the field are exhibiting proficiency at 93.8 %, this suggests that students are currently demonstrating appropriate professional behavior in the field. For Fall 2012, we will provide the site supervisors who complete the assessment with more guidance to ensure inter-rater reliability.</p> <p>Professionalism Essay: Students were at 80% proficiency, 5% below our target proficiency rate. This suggests that we need to spend more time in class working with the professional code of conduct and ethics to ensure student understanding. We will be working with the instructors in ensure scoring consistency on the rubrics.</p>
