1. **NURS 1080 Cohort: Fundamentals HESI Exam** 182 students took the Fundamentals HESI. The class average was 938, with 86% of students scoring above 800. Measure met.
2. **NURS 1580 Cohort: Gerontology HESI Exam** 220 students took the Gerontology HESI. The class average was 952, with 82% of students scoring above 800. Measure met.
3. **NURS 2680 Cohort: Final Exam: HESI** Final Exam for NURS 2680: 82% of students earned a score of 75% or higher on the final. Measure met.
4. **NCLEX Pass Rates: CNM (National)**

Data Results Period upon which this Action Plan is based (period which ended 6/30/13):

1. HESI Specialty test for NURS 1080 and 1580 – Cohort HESI Score average greater than 800; 71% of students scoring at 800 or better.
2. HESI Exit Exam for NURS 2680 – Cohort HESI Score average greater than 800; 71% of students scoring at 800 or better.
3. Final Exam grades for NURS 2680 – at least 71% of students will pass final examinations with a score of 75% or better.
4. NCSBN Board Reports (NCLEX Pass Rates) – Our end of year numbers need to be higher than the national average, which varies each quarter.

Action Plan (close the loop):

1. For NURS 1080, 182 students took the Fundamentals HESI. The class average was 938, with 86% of students scoring above 800. Measure met. For next reporting cycle, increase External/Direct benchmark 71% of students scoring at 850 or better.  
 For NURS 1580, 220 students took the Gerontology HESI. The class average was 952, with 82% of students scoring above 800. Measure met. For next reporting cycle, increase External/Direct benchmark 71% of students scoring at 850 or better.
2. For NURS 2680, 291 students took the E2 Exit HESI. The class average was 887, with 75% of students scoring above 800. Measure met. For next

reporting cycle, increase External/Direct benchmark 71% of students scoring at 850 or better.

- Final Exam for NURS 2680: 84% of students earned a score of 75% or higher on the final. Measure met. For next reporting cycle, Final exam for NURS 2680 is the HESI Exit E2 exam.
- NCLEX pass rates. According to the NCSBN, our NCLEX board pass rate for first time test takers for Summer 12- Spring 2013 shows an improvement overall. With the next reporting cycle, we anticipate further improvement. Measure stands without modification:
