Adult Basic Education (ABE) courses help students prepare for the GED/HiSET exam or learn English as a second language. The ABE program offers instruction to adults who do not have their high school diploma and to adults who do not speak English as their first language. There is a \$10.00 fee per academic term.

All students must first attend an orientation and take a placement test to determine their reading, math, language or English levels.

Students under 16 are not admitted to Adult Basic Education classes. If you are 16 or 17 years old, you must have an underage verification form from the school district that you last attended.

ORIENTATION IS THE FIRST STEP!

To register for an ABE orientation, visit the ABE website at cnm.edu/abe.

- Orientations are currently being held via Zoom.
- Each orientation is 1 1/2 hours in duration.
- Prospective students must stay for the entire time to get credit for attendance.
- Prospective students will receive a follow up email with information on how to join the program.
