

CNM EMS PROGRAM POLICY

REPETITION OF COURSES – PARAMEDIC-LEVEL COHORT

OVERVIEW: This policy is to outline the EMS Program guidelines for acceptable repetition of paramedic-level cohort courses.

SPECIFIC POLICY:

- Any student accepted into a paramedic cohort will be allowed no more than 2 attempts at *either* Term 1 or Term 2 of the cohort paramedic curriculum without EMS Program Director approval.
- Any student accepted into a paramedic cohort may not repeat both Term 1 and Term 2 without EMS Program Director approval.
 - In the event that a student accepted into a paramedic cohort does not successfully complete ALL courses of a given Term within the semester taken, that student will remain in the current Term and repeat those courses not successfully completed during the next available semester.
- An attempt is defined as registration and attendance of 2 or more class sessions.
