

Avant Language Exams Policy

CNM will grant college credit to students who earn passing scores on Avant STAMP 4S and Worldspeak Language Exams. Minimum required scores are listed below with the corresponding CNM credit award. Students should note that the credit awarded is based on the score earned. Students who would like to earn credit by taking an Avant Language Exam should contact the CNM Assessment Center to register.
